



If I can't make it to class, and can't make it up that week, I offer the next class either free or at a discount...Parents are usually very understanding and appreciative of this extra effort. 

"The biggest piece of advice we recommend is to start right and have a continuous focus on training and development, both on course content and effective learner engagement style.

Some of the policies that have worked well for us and are appreciated by parents are:

- 1. Almost all our class minimums are one, so we don't cancel classes even if there is only one learner enrolled.
- 2. We use some of the Outschool features quite extensively, like the transfer request feature and make-up classes feature for learners who may have a schedule conflict or have missed a class due to an emergency. This greatly reduces the stress for learners/parents."

Make sure you are teaching what you are passionate about and have a bigger purpose. For example, I teach coding because I want to empower kids to create their own video games and Minecraft mods. This gives kids the confidence to create cool things and believe in themselves. Yes, there is a lot more to being successful. Like marketing, class descriptions, course selection, and so on. But, I think these should come second after you have found your purpose in teaching.



This gave them an additional way to communicate with each other outside of class as well as a trial period to see if they enjoyed the group dynamic. I post weekly challenges to keep the students active and engaged. I always involve my students in choosing topics and themes for my challenges and posts.



My best advice for growing your business as an educator in 2023 would be to cross-promote your classes or group and engage your audience. Teachers that listen to their learners and engage with them on their topics of interest rarely struggle to fill classes...When you support your students and families, they will support your business! I have many students who are not only in my group but also take several of my classes because they feel heard and respected."


